Happy New Year! Hope you had a joyous and blessed 2022.

I am overdue and have plenty to share.

#### In 2022:

- Master's Table added 3 new board members who will add experience and passion to our organization.
- We added a new program called Food 2 Kids in September. This program provides kids with non-perishable food for the weekends, when they wouldn't have access to in school meal distribution.
- We served nearly 3300 meals and were again to the hall for those who wanted to come inside.
- We gave out nearly 3000 lbs of food from the Emergency Food Bank.
- The highest demand was met during the Thankşgiving and Christmas season, serving over 400 meals combined, distributing 130 gift cards, 60 bags of food and 61 frozen turkeys. We also teamed up with Traveler on a Mission and gave out 60 holiday stockings.
- We also welcomed back our beloved Parish Nurse, Maggie, who is once again performing blood pressure screenings and medical referrals for our guests in need.
